



How to Register for the JNESO MOBILE APP

The New JNESO Mobile App is for **“Members Only”** and requires registration to gain access to all the features. The JNESO App, which is available for cell phones and tablets, can be downloaded for free at the [Apple Store](#) and [Google Play](#).



HOW TO REGISTER

STEP 1. All JNESO members who have provided a valid email address to JNESO will receive an “invitation/member log in” email that will include a link to log in. The email will be from admin@jneso.org.

STEP 2. Click on the link and select **“Create Log In”** to start the registration process.

STEP 3. Enter full name, email, (should be self-populated), and then create and confirm a password. Click on the ‘CREATE’ button to submit. Once submitted, you will be taken to a page with a ‘LOG-IN’ button. Just ignore this and go to next step.

STEP 4. Download the App from the Apple Store or Google Play – to search type in the word “JNESO”. If you have already downloaded the JNESO App you can open the App and click on the gear icon and log in.

STEP 5. Use your email and password you created to **log in**.

Navigating the new JNESO Mobile App

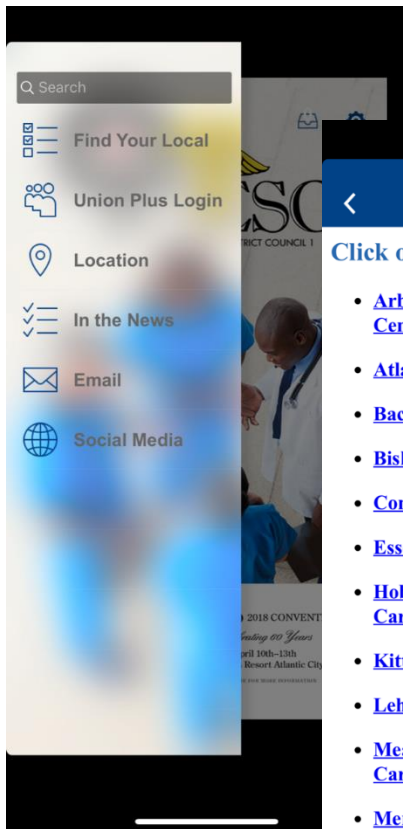
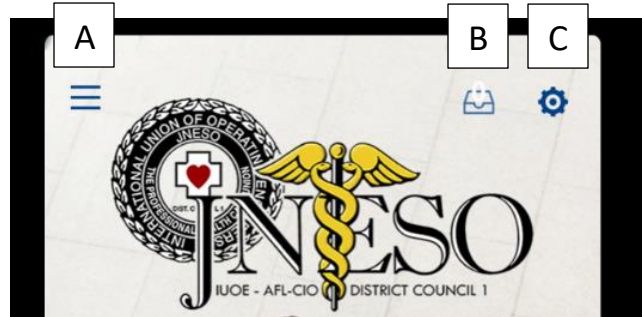
The new App puts JNESO information at your fingertips.

Nurses and LVH-Pocono reach agreement

(Pocono Record) Nurses with the Lehigh Valley Hospital-Pocono reach three-year contract with the hospital, but not without taking some parting shots. The nurses are represented by JNESO, the healthcare union, a New Jersey-based union. The contract will cover about 400 full-time, part-time and per diem registered nurses employed by the hospital.
