In the event your Employer has not provided the proper safety equipment [PPE], you have the right to file a complaint with OSHA or the Department of Health.

OSHA	You (or your representative) have the right to file a confidential safety and health complaint and request an OSHA inspection of your workplace if you believe there is a serious hazard or if you think your employer is not following OSHA standards.
